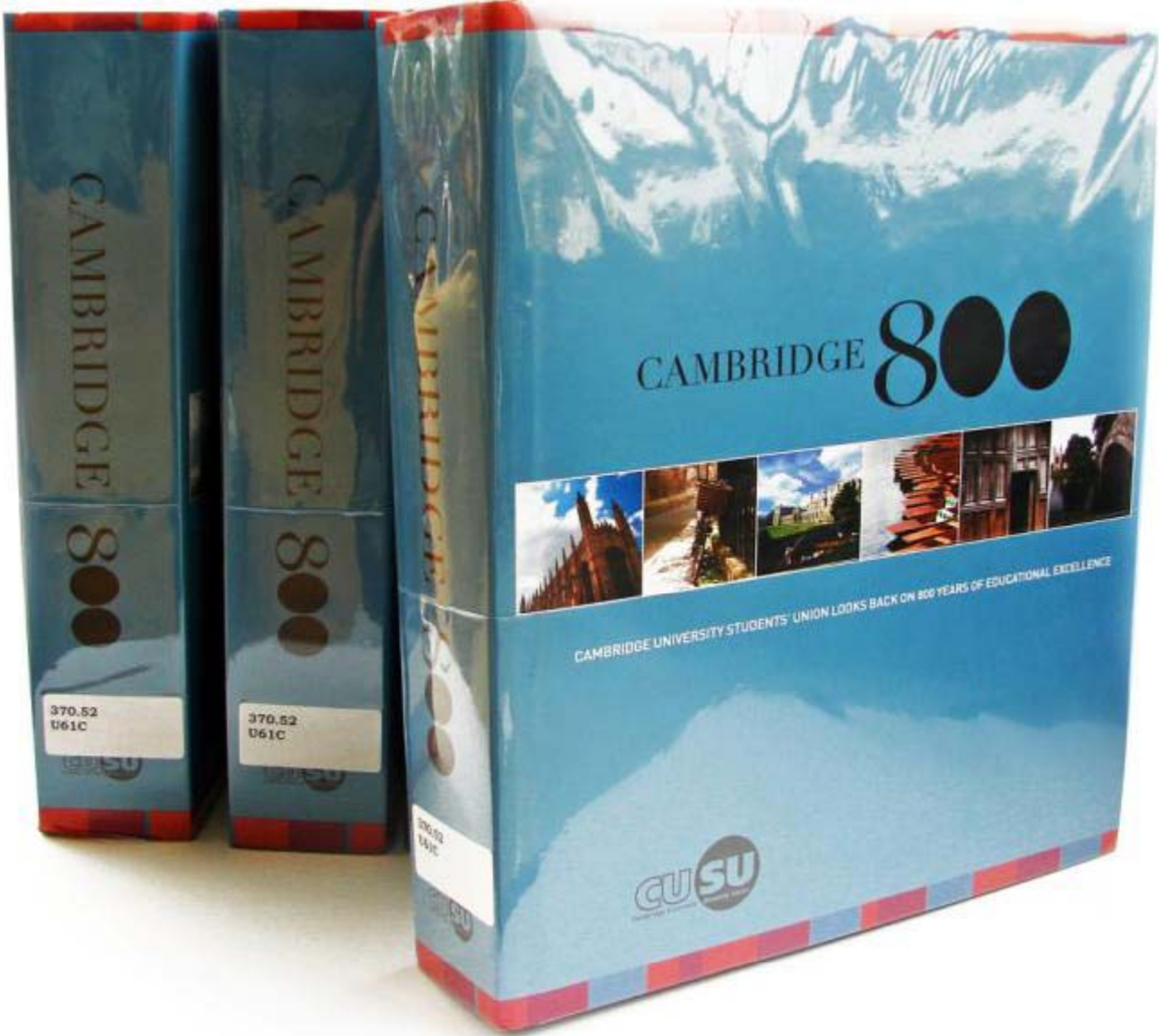

Newton College in Peru provides exceptional education and a lifelong understanding of the importance of the environment. The school's curriculum is designed to provide students with a strong foundation in science, technology, and business. Newton College in Lima, Peru, is a private, co-educational, British-style day school for girls and boys aged 3 to 18, with a college study centre in the American tradition, was established in 1968.

Newton College delivers a holistic education as reflected by its mission statement. We are a Peruvian British school, committed to developing the full potential of our pupils in order for them to become well-rounded and successful citizens. The school integrates the concept of 'holistic education' as the ability to achieve personal goals that promote a shared concern for one's community and environment. In line with its mission statement, the college offers programmes of the International Baccalaureate (IB) and the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) of Cambridge University.

One of the principal attributes in the school's pupil profile are innovation and audacity. The college nurtures innovation as the capacity to work creatively with curiosity and thought. It interprets audacity as the capacity to overcome challenges and make decisions with courage and perseverance.

The college has demonstrated sustainable innovation and audacity itself on two important occasions. In 1997 it became the first school in Peru to offer the IB Diploma Programme. The programme is now world renowned as excellent preparation for university studies and life. At present there are approximately 1000 students in study from schools all around the world. By the year 2000 it is estimated there will be a million IB students in 10,000 schools. The IB Diploma is accepted as a university entrance qualification all over the world, including by all British universities. In the UK, 100 schools currently deliver it and it has become a serious alternative to A levels.

However, in 1997 very few people had heard of the programme in Peru and the school led an information campaign with limited success. Despite initial scepticism it now leads a few institutions to give direct entry to students with the IB Diploma. Now, 20 years later, the most prestigious universities in Peru are competing with each other to attract Diploma students, offering them not only direct entry but also a wide range of credits.
