Dear Parents,

As part of our Book Month celebrations, **this year we will be holding our traditional Book Fair from Tuesday 16th to Saturday 20th April** in the upper levels of the SUM and the surrounding gardens. This event brings together 12 bookshops offering a wide variety of books for all tastes and ages. In addition, we will have the visit of several authors who will give talks to the students, read their books for them and sign autographs (see programme [here](#)).



Students will visit the fair with their teachers during school hours and select their favourite books, in English and Spanish, in all reading levels and genres.

Early Years: Students will take home a [booklet](#) with the selection of books they liked best, including price and stand number. Parents may visit the fair to purchase these or other books during the following hours: **Tuesday through Friday, from dismissal time until 5:30 p.m.** (Wednesday the fair closes at 3:30 p.m.), entrance will be through gate K. **Saturday, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.** Entrance will be through gate A (next to the theatre).

Lower School: Students will take home a [booklet](#) with the selection of books they liked best, including price and stand number. Parents may visit the fair to purchase these or other books during the following hours: **Tuesday through Friday, from dismissal time until 5:30 p.m.** (Wednesday the fair closes at 3:30). **Saturday, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.** Entrance will be through gate A. Students in Grades 4 and 5 may bring cash to purchase books directly at the fair.

Upper School: Parents may visit the fair during the following hours: **Tuesday through Friday, from dismissal time until 5:30 p.m.** (Wednesday the fair closes at 3:30 p.m.). **Saturday, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.** Entrance will be through gate A.

Through this activity we want to promote the love of reading among our students of all ages. In addition, this is an excellent opportunity for them to acquire books of their liking and thus enrich their own library.
