If we want our students to truly internalize our core values, they must see that they are practised at home, at school and in society in general. It is for this reason that Newton College is developing an ethical guide for the entire school community.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF THIS GUIDE?

- If children see that the same values are practised at home and at school, they will appreciate their universal significance more clearly, they will better understand their own environment and will have more confidence in themselves.
- If all families reinforce these core values, parents will have better communication with their children, will improve their children's self-esteem and will feel more secure as parents.
- If all staff members reinforce the school values, they will also have better communication with the students, a better understanding with parents and the students' behaviours will improve.
- The guide gives examples of the daily behaviors expected of students, parents and staff. It does not impinge on religious, spiritual, family or cultural values; it is limited to the four universal values that the school is focused on.
- This is the ethical guide proposed for parents. It is a dynamic guide that can adapt and develop over time.

6	I am open-minded, I accept that other people with their differences may also be right, and I am willing to redefine my own ideas.
7	I demonstrate and promote the principles and values of education for sustainable development through my own actions and practices at home.
8	I recognize the value of time, arriving punctually at meetings and events, fulfilling my obligations to the school within the established deadlines.
9	I display good manners, communicating in a courteous and friendly way, and am grateful for the support and services provided to me.

4	I am sincere, transparent and trustworthy both in word and action, honoring my commitments and fulfilling my responsibilities.
5	I treat everyone impartially and fairly, giving them equal opportunity, support and recognition.
6	I look for all the relevant information and consider the different perspectives of a situation before reaching a conclusion.
7	I acknowledge the authority of the school's security personnel and follow their instructions at all times.
8	I am familiar with the school's academic honesty policy and fully reinforce its principles and rules.
9	Laccept the responsibility for my actions, recognizing my mistakes and accepting constructive advice with openness

9	I contribute to a climate of community well-being and trust wherever I am: at home, at work, in my community.
